BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board ratifies and authorizes the Superintendent, in consultation with the Troy City Schools Board of Education, to modify the face mask requirement as he deems advisable, depending on the local conditions.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Board of Education directs the superintendent to prepare to implement and broadly communicate these requirements to faculty, staff, parents and community members.
